



Job Description PNG Line Pilot

Reports to: Country Director on all matters non-aviation related. All aviation related matters report to the Chief Pilot.

Minimum Skills & Qualifications Required:

- FAA or equivalent Commercial Pilot Certificate with Instrument and Single-Engine Seaplane rating
- Airframe and Powerplant Certificate preferred, not required
- Completed flight assessment as prescribed by the aviation committee
- Must be able to pass a CASA First Class Medical (EKG required)
- No minimum hours

General Description:

This position is viewed by Samaritan Aviation first and foremost to be a Christian ministry position. As a missionary, this person is expected to carry out their specific role as a servant of our Lord Jesus Christ in a way that advances the Kingdom of God in PNG. The person in this position will need to fulfill their responsibilities with professionalism along with a spirit of cooperation with other members of the Samaritan Aviation staff. This position will primarily be conducting Life Flights, Medical Supply Flights and Disaster Relief Flights.

Core Competencies:

- A clear call to the mission field
- A servant's heart, committed to a lifestyle of sacrificial service
- Teachable, a willingness to learn, has an intellectual curiosity
- Ability to Process short and long-term stress.
- Willingness to be flex and adjust to changing circumstances
- Team player
- Problem solver along with situational awareness.
- Self-starter
- Goal directed
- Self-disciplined

Aviation Responsibilities:

- Perform on-call flight duties when assigned
- Responsible for maintaining a valid medical certificate
- Update flight management software
- Maintain proficiency in emergency procedures
- Ensure aircraft is in a n airworthy condition prior to flight
- Adhere to CASA and Samaritan Aviation regulation and policies
- Maintain effective communication with Chief Pilot and Director of Maintenance around aircraft maintenance issues
- Participate in ongoing training
- Participate in the Hospital Ministry

- Pray for each patient prior to flight
- Maintain positive relationships with contacts in the villages and aid posts

Ministry Responsibilities:

- Initiate contact and develop relationships in villages and aid posts for evangelistic and mentoring purposes.
- Develop a mentoring/discipleship plan with national staff.
- Participate in evangelism opportunities in Wewak and along the Sepik.
- Be willing and able to assist as needed in the Hospital ministry and outreach efforts.

Samaritan Aviation is committed to maximizing the efficiency of all mission-related activities, with aviation being one of our highest priorities. For Samaritan Aviation to conduct safe flight operations and also maximize the delivery of medical and disaster relief supplies, it is important for our organization to consider that ministry is maximized with increased payload. Therefore, flight crew weight is a factor in the candidate screening process, and a consideration for our pilots on the field. Please note that these requirements are permitted by the Religion Clauses of the First Amendment.
